City integrated waste services transfer to Burrtec Waste Industries effective April 1

SAN BERNARDINO, CA, February 23, 2016 – On Monday, Jan. 25, the Mayor and Common Council unanimously approved a 10-year exclusive franchise agreement with [Burrtec Waste Industries, Inc](#) to provide solid waste, street sweeping and right-of-way cleanup services to the City's 46,800 plus customer base.

The outsourcing of integrated waste is a key component to the City's plan to exit bankruptcy. The new contract will upgrade service levels and generates \$24.9 million in franchise fees paid by Burrtec, while eliminating an estimated \$20 million in deferred and future equipment maintenance and replacement costs. The new franchise revenue received over the 10-year term will be allocated to other much-needed programs such as public safety, street maintenance and more.

Effective Apr. 1, customers can expect to see Burrtec providing trash and recycling collection, street sweeping twice a month, right-of-way cleanup, and bulky item pickup services. Throughout the month of March, Burrtec will mail information to customers regarding available services and billing processes. They will also hold several community meetings to assist residents with the transition. Current scheduled meetings are as follows:
