The San Bernardino Hometown Heroes Military Banner Program will recognize the brave men and women of San Bernardino currently serving in the United States Armed Forces. The personalized banners will be displayed on light poles up and down the major streets throughout the City to honor, celebrate, and remind residents of their dedication to our country.

Criteria

To qualify, honorees must meet the following criteria:

- Active duty member of the United States Armed Forces; and
- Current City of San Bernardino resident; or
- Have graduated from a high school in San Bernardino; or
- Immediate family member of a current resident (wife/husband, son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, son-in-law/daughter-in-law)

Please note: annual verification of active duty status will be required

What is the Cost of Each Banner?

A donation of \$300 is requested for each banner. All monies received for this program are considered tax deductible and can be claimed under tax-id # 95-6000772. There is a limit of one per service person.
