The San Bernardino Public Library's summer reading game theme this year is "Paws to Read". The library will be hosting "Paws to Read: Whose Tracks Are These?" live animal show in the Kellogg Rooms of the Feldheym Central Library on Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at 4:00 P.M.

Can you identify an animal just by looking at its tracks? Sure you can! This year we "paws" to read, learn and identify the tracks each animal leaves and how they move. Do they fly, hop, slither, crawl, or run?

For more than 25 years, Pacific Animal Productions has been dedicated to conserving wildlife and endangered species while educating people about the wonders of wildlife. They incorporate "edu-tainment" into their presentations to engage the audience and give them a safe environment to see, touch and learn about animals, reptiles, and bugs.

The "Paws to Read" summer reading game begins on Saturday, June 7 and runs through Saturday, August 2, 2014. There is a reading game for children, for teens, and for adults.
