Larry Eby writes out of Southern California. His first book, *Flight of August*, is the winner of the 2013 Louise Bogan Award from Trio House Press. His work has recently appeared in Passages North, THRUSH, Arroyo Literary Review, The Black Tongue Review, The Redlands Review, Poetry Quarterly, The Sand Canyon Review, Badlands, The Coachella Review, Aperçus Quarterly, Welter, Inlandia, The Secret Handshake, and Call of the Wild: Being Human by Editions Bibliotekos, as well as others.

Apart from scribbling away in his home, he is an active member of PoetriE, an Inland Empire based writing community, and recently founded his own press, Orange Monkey Publishing. He has also served as the poetry editor for Ghost Town, CSUSB's national literary journal, and on the Board of Publications for the Inlandia Institute.
