

New Digital Content for the San Bernardino Public Library

San Bernardino Public Library is now offering free online access to complete digital copies of your favorite magazines. Magazines are available to download for free from the library's website, www.sbpl.org. Using your San Bernardino Public Library card and Smart Phone, tablet, or personal computer, you can gain access to more than 100 publications, including ESPN, Us Weekly, Newsweek, Rolling Stone, Martha Stewart Living, PC World, and many more.

First time users will need to create a user name and password to access the Zinio site. They will then have unlimited access to full digital copies of Zinio's magazine collection, available via computer or mobile devices.

Browse from the library's collection of popular titles with no holds, no checkout periods, and no limit to the number of magazines you can download. The service is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and unlike print-format magazines, digital magazines don't need to be returned and are never overdue.

"We're pleased to offer yet another resource that is available to our library cardholders with Internet access whenever and wherever," said Library Director Ed Erjavek.

The library is also offering library card holders a Classic Title eCollection through One Click Digital. The collection offers 200 eAudiobook classic titles for download or streaming on PCs, eReaders and mobile devices.
