Distracted Driver Enforcement:

The San Bernardino Police Department conducted a citywide proactive traffic enforcement detail focusing on distracted driver violations from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM on Monday, April 13, 2015.

During this program 137 vehicles were stopped. 2 people were arrested for warrants, 53 people were issued citations for cell phone violations, and 4 drivers were issued a citation for texting while driving. 18 drivers were cited for driving on a suspended or revoked license or being unlicensed, and 44 citations were issued for other miscellaneous traffic violations. 19 vehicles were impounded with 9 of them placed on a 30-day.

This program was part of San Bernardino Police Department's ongoing efforts to reduce the number of fatalities and injuries resulting from traffic collisions.

Funding for this program was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
