

San Bernardino Public Library to Host Summer Meals for Children

Two of the San Bernardino City Library branches, in partnership with the nonprofit organization 180 Degrees and Still Standing, will be providing meals to children for this year's Summer Meal Program. Summertime brings a break from school, but the need for good nutrition doesn't take a break!

Funded by the United States Department of Agriculture, summer meal programs offer families a great way to stretch their family food budgets. Summer meal programs also help ensure that, while school is out, children in the community have continued access to the healthy food and learning opportunities essential to their development. Children and teens are not only well-fed, but in a safe environment, which often provides fun or educational activities that help them return to school, healthy and ready to learn.

- The Feldheym Central Library will offer lunch from 12:00 PM-1:00 PM on Monday through Thursday from June 1 through July 30, 2015. The library is located at 555 West Sixth Street in San Bernardino.
- The Villasenor Branch Library will offer a meal from 3:30-4:30 on Monday and Tuesday and from 1:00-2:00 on Wednesday and Thursday from June 1-July 30, 2015. The library is located at 525 N. Mt. Vernon Ave. in San Bernardino.

Summer meal sites are open to all kids and teens 18 years and younger. It is free and there is no paperwork or enrollment requirement!
