Built in the 1950s, the City of San Bernardino Animal Shelter has seen its fair share of good times and bad. Although the facility was never designed to take in the almost 15,000 animals each year, somehow the staff makes it happen. The facility has grown in the past few years, with the addition of a puppy building and an administrative building, yet the facility still struggles under the natural deterioration that comes with maintaining an older structure. With the City's declaration of bankruptcy in August of 2012, the decision was made to absorb the Animal Shelter as part of the Police Department in order to save money. During the bankruptcy period, ordering of everyday items such as office supplies & such were placed on hold and the staff's benefits and pay were affected. But despite all the adversity, the staff has maintained a positive attitude and dedication to care for every animal every day.
