Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Enforcement:

The San Bernardino Police Department deployed additional officers to conduct a citywide Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Operation from 7:00am to 2:00pm on Monday, July 20, 2015 with a special focus on violations that have been noted as the primary collision factor on many traffic collisions in our city.

During this detail officers contacted 57 motorists, 12 bicyclists, and 31 pedestrians. 86 citations were issued in all, with 7 to bicyclists, and 23 to pedestrians. 1 person was arrested for warrants. 13 citations were issued to people driving unlicensed or on a suspended/revoked license. 10 vehicles were impounded with 4 of those on 30-day holds.

This program was part of San Bernardino Police Department's ongoing efforts to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in traffic collisions.

Funding for this operation is provided by a grant from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration through the California Office of Traffic Safety.
