

## **Villasenor Branch Library shifts to "Winter Hours"**

Hours at the Villasenor Branch Library of the San Bernardino Public Library will shift to “winter hours” beginning Monday, Nov. 2, 2015. “The library board of trustees wants the public to be able to make maximum usage of available library service hours,” Library Director Ed Erjavek said in a news release. “Villasenor, which is at 525 N Mount Vernon Avenue, will now be open from 1 to 6 PM on Mondays and Tuesdays”, he said. It had previously been open from 3 to 8 PM, and will return to those hours on March 14, 2016 after Daylight Saving Time returns. Hours on Wednesdays and Thursdays will remain at 10 AM to 3 PM.

Library hours will not change at the city’s other libraries. Feldheim Central Library is open Monday through Thursday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturday from 1 to 6 PM. Rowe Branch Library is open Monday and Tuesday from 3 to 8 PM, and Wednesday and Thursday from 10 AM to 3 PM.

Library service, including check out of materials, is available at Inghram Branch Library Tuesday to Friday from 2 to 6 PM and Saturday 10 to 2 PM. The facility is open in partnership with Solomon Ujamaa Center, Inc., including its activities Tuesday-Friday at 10 AM and Saturday 10 AM to 4 PM.

Online library services for library cardholders, including eBooks and Audiobooks; full-text magazine articles; popular magazine articles in electronic format; a business directory; online homework assistance available via chat from 1 to 10 PM daily; practice online tests for the GED, ASVAB and job-related tests; and other resources can also be accessed by going to the library website at [www.sbpl.org](http://www.sbpl.org) and selecting “E for Me.”
