#### Narcotics Unit Recovers 20,000 Rainbow Fentanyl Pills

There has been significant discussion in the media regarding "Rainbow Fentanyl," in American communities. On February 15, the Narcotics Unit conducted a traffic stop and recovered 20,000 fentanyl pills, along with 2.2 pounds of black tar heroin. One subject was arrested for the drugs.

### Illegal Cannabis Operations Shut Down

Southern District Resource officers, along with the Bureau of Cannabis Control, conducted investigations into illegal marijuana dispensaries and grows in the city.

A search warrant operation was conducted on February 15 at multiple locations and 6,572 marijuana plants were seized, along with 812 pounds of marijuana.
